Course Code	ERTH 3703
Course Title	Isotope Geochemistry and Geochronology
Course Description	This course looks at stable and radiogenic isotope systematics applied to different Earth environments. Students will delve into geochronological techniques and their applications, and apply the principles of elemental and isotopic fractionation to investigate several geological processes. Lecture 1.5 hours per week, a laboratory three hours per week.

Anticipated TA Support	1 TA @ 130 hrs for lab
Required qualifications	The minimum requirement for this position is a Ph.D. in Earth Sciences with a specialization in geochemistry and isotope geochemistry. Preference will be given to candidates with teaching experience.
