We invite everyone to bring in an “interesting” rock of which we will provide one cut through the rock and lap one face of the cut to polish it. The preferred size would be somewhere around the size of a closed fist (as in rock, paper, scissors).

This is an opportunity to cut open that rock that you always wondered what it looked like inside; whether it is fossiliferous, sedimentary, metamorphic or igneous. The colours and textures inside can astonish you if you are able to bring in an interesting rock. If you do not have access to fist sized rocks we will have a small supply for you to choose from at the Rocklab.
